**Accuracy** Is the information free of errors and backed by evidence?



The search relevance landscape is rapidly shifting. Due to the rise of Transformers and Large Language Models (LLMs) and the more recent emergent capabilities shown with Foundation Models, public search engines are now rushing to integrate models like chatGPT directly into the search experience as a form of "generative search". These models can perform abstractive question answering, summarization, and even new content generation, but when untethered from underlying search results, often hallucinate bogus or misleading information. As search relevance practitioners, it's important for us to know how these technologies work and how to best integrate them into search experiences to drive accurate, relevant results. The more\_like\_this query finds documents that are "like" a given set of documents. To do so, MLT selects a set of representative terms of these input documents, forms a query using these terms, executes the query and returns the results. The user controls the input documents, how the terms should be selected and how the query is formed.

The simplest use case consists of asking for documents that are similar to a provided piece of text. Here, we are asking for all movies that have some text similar to "Once upon a time" in their "title" and in their "description" fields, limiting the number of selected terms to 12.



#### Session Abstract

At Climate Policy Radar, we're building an open-source knowledge graph for climate policy. In this talk, we'll share how we combine in-house expertise with scalable data infrastructure to identify key concepts in thousands of global climate policy documents. We'll also touch on ontology design, equitable evaluation, and the climate impacts of Al.

#### Session Description

We'll take you on a technical deep-dive into how we've built and scaled a knowledge graph which maps the relationships between thousands of climate policy concepts, and identifies where those concepts appear in our corpus of climate policy and other climate-relevant documents.

We'll share the high-level methodology, infrastructure decisions, and evaluation framework which have allowed our small team to process millions of passages of text while maintaining high standards for fairness and accuracy.
